## May 24, 2009

### **Fruits of the Spirit (Faithfulness, Gentleness, Self-Control)**

Galatians 5:22-23

Try memorizing Galatians 5:22-23 this week. You may want to write the verse on paper. That helps us remember things easier. Sometimes thinking of a silly sentence helps us remember a list of things. Make a list of the nine “fruits” of the Spirit mentioned in Galatians 5:22-23. Take the first letter of each one mentioned in the Bible (L, J, P, P, K, G, F, G, and S). Now make up a silly sentence to help you remember the letters in order. Try something like “Little Johnny Put Plenty (of) Ketchup (on) Grandma’s ... You can finish the sentence for yourself. Now see if that silly sentence helps you remember the nine fruits of the Spirit in the order that they are mentioned in the Bible. And now you have just about memorized the verses!

## May 31, 2009

### **Pentecost**

Acts 2:1-21, 37-47

When Pentecost came, many people from many places gathered together for the celebration. Make a snack mix that reminds you of all the different people that gathered together. You can mix pretzels, candy corn, raisins, marshmallows, and M&Ms®. God loved all the different people from all the different places. That is what the disciples taught them that day, too - that God’s love was for all of them. Your snack mix can remind you that God’s love is for you and all the different people you know.
