March Bible Verse

March 1, 2009

Follow Me

John 1:35-51

Play a game of "Follow the Leader" with your child. You can be the leader and your child has to go where you go and do what you do. Swap places. Your child is the leader and you have to be the follower. Remind your child that Jesus told some men to follow him. It was not just a game, though. They would work with Jesus, be his helpers, and tell others about God.

March 8, 2009

You are the Messiah

Matthew 16:13-18

Use a favorite recipe to make M&M® cookies with your child. As you make them, ask your child what special name Simon Peter called Jesus in the story this week. Simon Peter said Jesus was the Messiah. Let your child add M&Ms® to the tops of the cookies before they bake. Be sure the "M" is face up. Say "M" is for "Messiah." That is what they called Jesus.

March 15, 2009

Wash My Feet

John 13:1-9, 14

Trace your child's foot and cut out several footprints. Turn the foot so the toes are at the top and let your child draw a smiley face near the top. Color the footprints. Ask your child what Jesus did to the feet of his friends. Was Jesus being kind to them? Does Jesus want us to be kind to others, too? Being kind to others makes us happy and it makes the other people happy, too.

March 22, 2009

Pray with Me

Mark 14:32-42

Use bedtime as a prayer time with your child. Remind him or her that Jesus prayed and talked to God. We can pray and talk to God just like Jesus did. Try to do this every night this week.

March 29, 2009

Peter's Denial

Mark 14:26-31, 66-72; John 21:15-17

Sing this song with your child to the tune of "I'm a Little Teapot."
